

NORHED- Rupantaran, TU and Shree Jana Jiwan Secondary School Team Exposure Visit to Shree Janahit Secondary School

On March 25th, 2022, Tribhuvan University and Kathmandu University Rupantaran Team, and Jana Jiwan Secondary School team had a team exposure visit to Shree Janahit Secondary School. Some Rupantaran members of TU and KU, Jana Jiwan Secondary School team, Board Member of Jana Jiwan School, Ward Chairman of Khairahani-2, Chitwan, and Teachers from Janahit Secondary School were present in Teacher Exchange Program. In this exposure visit, Jana Jiwan Team visited Janahit Secondary School Daapcha-9, kavrepalanchok. The main objective of this program was to share the teaching-learning approach by both schools and changes that have been made after the involvement of the RUPANTARAN team.

In this program, Jana Jiwan Secondary School and some Rupantaran members were the visiting teams where they visited the school garden, Ecosan Toilet, STEAM lab, Library, ICT Center, ECD classroom, and agriculture farm. The team from Jana Jiwan Secondary School also have shared their knowledge regarding agriculture, practical knowledge, teaching-learning pattern, involvement of students in School Gardening, and Organic farming. Janahit Headteacher, Ms. Teena Shilpakar shared overall experience and hard work by teachers throughout the Rupantaran journey, how they have tackled the problems during the first phase of the project.

After the visit, a workshop was held on Bhakundebesi where the issues were discussed and had a sharing with both teams for further improvement of school gardening and teaching-learning pedagogy. A fruitful discussion on improvement and update of Ecosan project where a professor from TU has shared his knowledge on how we can make more effective ecosan system and sustainable agriculture. The teacher from Janahit Secondary School gave a presentation based on changes that have been made by the Rupantaran team. Mr. Ram Prasad Neupane presented project-based learning and shared how the school has changed after the Rupantaran project. Mrs. Dhana Maya shared practical based teaching and learning. Ms. Teena Shilpakar presented how they have engaged to make changes in school and the help of the Rupantaran team to make it successful.
