Eco-San was working well and the vegetables at the greenhouse were growing properly. Support has been given to the kiwi which helps them to grow further.

After an overall visit to the school classroom, lab, gardening, and farming, School Principal, Ms. Teena Shilpakar, presented a short session on the progress work done by the Rupantaran project at Shree Janahit Secondary School.
